Executive Summary

Client Requirement

National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) awarded a consultancy project for Designing National Seismic Risk Mitigation Program (NSRMP) under the National Cyclone Risk Mitigation Project, Phase-II to DDF-AKDN JV, a Joint Venture between DDF Consultants Private Limited (DDF) and Aga Khan Agency for Habitat India (AKDN).

The project involved Rapid Visual Screening (RVS) and measurement survey of government buildings across India, to identify buildings for retrofitting - for protecting them against earthquake risk.

Client Challenges

The Client's challenges in Meghalaya and Manipur included:

- 56 numbers of Government facilities were spread in a large Geographical spread of 22.429 sq km of area with peculiar topography, rugged terrain, extreme weather conditions, unique geographical and geoclimatic settings.
- The requirement of a high degree of precision and technical competency for collecting the required data.
- The difficulty of finding suitable technical and skillful teams in these areas to undertake the Survey.
- Corona Covid 19 restrictions, leading to difficult inter and intra state movements for the Survey teams.
- Coordinating timely permissions from government departments, for each facility to be surveyed.

Service Level Requirements

- Execution of RVS within 30 days of issuing the Work order.
- The assessment of RVS parameters as per the approved RVS form through Questionnaires.
- Interaction with the Government officials of each facility and obtaining social, environmental and technical data.
- Recording of the data daily and uploading using a mobile app.
- Take photographs of all facilities with GPS coordinates and daily uploading.

Process Followed for the Project

- Understanding the problem statement and depth analysis of client needs.
- Shortlisting competent manpower from the resource pool.
- Conduct training sessions for the selected manpower.
- Conduct of a pilot to streamline the process.
- Coordination with Surveyors to liaise with government departments, conduct the surveys, and take photographs of every facility.
- Daily feedback and regular interactions with the Client.
